





Ranjit is drawing a rectangle on a grid. He thinks the perimeter will be 9cm when it is complete.



Female Pirates

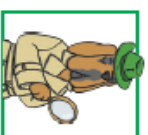
7 Many years ago, women were not allowed
